1. Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Goods (Liquefied Petroleum Gas Cylinders) Regulations.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, "liquefied petroleum gas cylinder" means a vessel approved for storage and carriage of liquefied petroleum gas and is of any of the following capacities:

9; 14; 19 and 48 kilograms.

3. Restriction on import and export of cylinders

No person shall import or export liquefied petroleum gas cylinders bearing the brand or trade name of a company without the written permission of the company.

4. Offence and penalty

A person who contravenes regulation 3 commits an offence and is liable to conviction to a fine not exceeding P500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or to both such fine and imprisonment.
