

Government Notice No. 56 of 2019

**THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND
SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT**

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the
Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment) Regulations 2019.
2. In these regulations –
“principal regulations” means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.
3. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (3)(f), in the definition of “competent authority”, in paragraph (c), by inserting, after the word “Singapore”, the words “, United Arab Emirates”.
4. The Ninth Schedule to the principal regulations is amended –
 - (a) in item 1, in the third column, by adding the following new paragraphs –

- (c) in item 3, in the third column, by adding the following new paragraphs, the existing provision being numbered as paragraph (1) –

- (d) by adding the following new item and its corresponding entries –

5. (1) Regulations 3 and 4 insofar as it relates to items 1(5), 2(3) and 3(3) shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2019.

(2) Regulation 4 insofar as it relates to items 1(4), 2(2) and 3(2) shall be deemed to have come into operation on 13 December 2018.
