THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act 1998

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Export to the United States of America (AGOA) (Amendment) Regulations 2003.
- 2. In these regulations
 "principal regulations" means the Export to the United States of America
 (AGOA) Regulations 2000.
- 3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended-
 - (a) by deleting the definition of "AGOA" and replacing it by the following definition-
 - "AGOA" means the Africa Growth and Opportunity Act enacted in the United States of America on 18 May 2000 as amended in 2002.
 - (b) By deleting the definition of "product" and replacing it by the following definition-
 - "product" means any textile and apparel article as described in the First Schedule under the item "Group" in respect of which preferential treatment is claimed;
- 4. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is amended in paragraph (b) by deleting the words "Third Schedule" and replacing them by the words "Second Schedule"
- 5. The Schedules to the principal regulations are amended by repealing the First, Second and Third Schedules and replacing them by the First and Second Schedules specified in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 6. These regulations shall come into operation on 6 August 2003.
